

- **IT'S PAID OFF!** We're very thankful to announce the **auxiliary loan** for the parking lot has been paid off. At the beginning of the year the loan had a balance of \$28,000 and 12 years to run with payments of \$256 a month, that would have cost the church almost \$37,000. Treasurer **Jones Gamble** recommended we try and pay the loan off by the end of the year in order to save \$9,000 in interest charges. Members responded generously and made a special effort to get the loan paid off even earlier—before our new evangelist Jerry Manning arrived to do the Lord's work here in West Columbia. This is wonderful, especially considering how many members are widows and/or are on fixed incomes. We're thankful to God for the encouraging love of his children here at West Columbia.
